But perhaps this was the perfect reminder of the reality of the Incarnation.

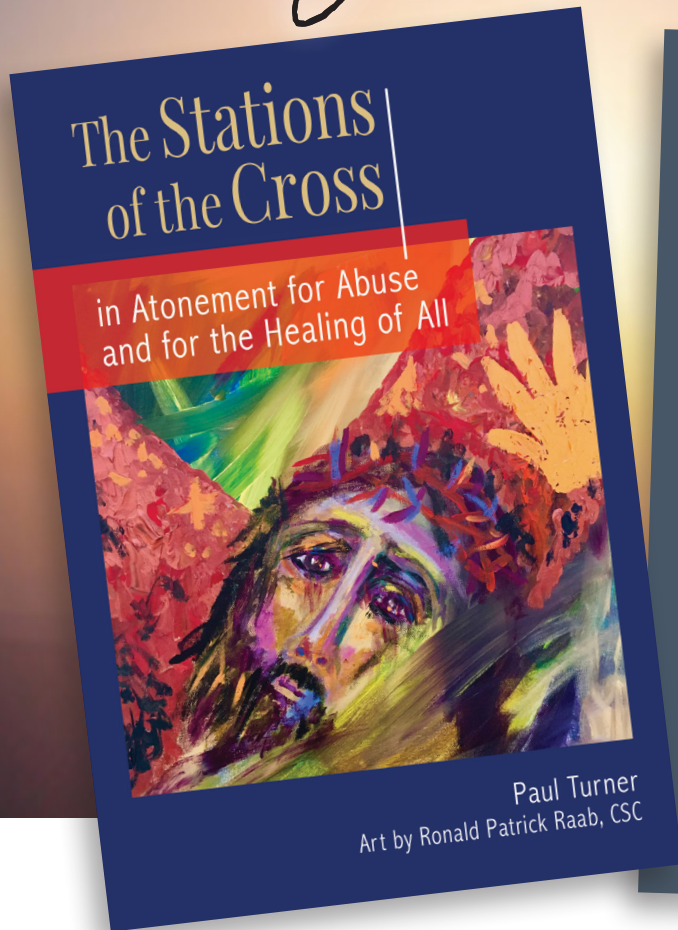
The Incarnation is a celebration of lowliness. God's love for God's people made manifest in Jesus Christ shows us that the Christian path is one of descent. Christ invites us to relinquish power and status for the sake of humility and community. May we recall our "lowly" Christmas celebrations throughout the coming year as we respond to this invitation, not with sadness or disappointment but with the hope promised in the Prologue to John's Gospel we heard on Christmas day: "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us, and we saw his glory" (John 1: 14). May we continue to see God's glory revealed in the vulnerability modeled by Christ as we move into Ordinary Time I, Lent, the Paschal Triduum and Easter.
