

As we look forward to Lent, Triduum, and Easter I am reminded of the words of Blessed Basil Moreau: "Human life is like a great Way of the Cross. Know of our continued prayers for you from Collegeville, Minnesota. Most sincerely,





Simple Psalter for Solemnities, Feasts, and Other Celebrations



Michael Joncas's new *Simple Psalter* is an attempt to synthesize elements of previous styles of psalm-singing into a new pattern of engaging these sacred texts. Using the new *Abbey Psalms and Canticles*, Joncas sets every responsorial psalm in the three-year Lectionary in settings that work equally well a cappella or with keyboard accompaniment, using psalm tones notated in proposed speechrhythm. The *Simple Psalter* is divided into four volumes: one for solemnities, feasts, and other celebrations, and one each for years A, B and C.

Fr. Jan Michael Joncas has composed and arranged more than three hundred pieces of liturgical music and is the author of six books. He most recently served as a faculty member, artist-in-residence, and research fellow in Catholic Studies at the University of St. Thomas in St. Paul, Minnesota


