

Dear Friends,

In Chapter 48 of his Rule, Saint Benedict encourages monastics to see sacred reading as part of their daily "manual labor," including committing to a particular book each Lent. Sister Judith Sutera, OSB, notes that sacred or divine reading (*lectio divina*) is "not an add-on that one does when there's spare time around other responsibilities, it is something that has its own designated slot on the agenda" (*St. Benedict's Rule: An Inclusive Translation and Daily Commentary*, Liturgical Press, 2021).

As a parish minister, I have always considered it a responsibility and privilege to connect (busy) parishioners with books and resources to help them reflect and grow, not unlike what Saint Benedict envisioned. While the needs of parishioners are diverse, our Spring 2025 Parish Resources Catalog contains a variety of possibilities to help parishioners read, pray, share, and grow in faith.
