


The time has come to tell the entire story of the creation of The Saint John's Bible. This completely updated and expanded edition of Illuminating the Word devotes a separate chapter to each of the Bible's seven volumes. Readers get a behind-the-scenes tour of the creation of each volume, with a fascinating window into the activities, challenges, and struggles at Donald Jackson's Scriptorium in Wales. We can practically watch, through the eyes of every artist and calligrapher who participated in the project, the Bible's stunning illuminations move from conception to completion. This edition includes a completely new chapter on the scripts used in The Saint John's Bible that will fascinate calligraphers and lovers of the art. Still another new chapter details the production of the Heritage Edition, a high-quality, fine-art facsimile of the original that makes The Saint John's Bible available to a wider audience than the singular manuscript.

Christopher Calderhead is a visual artist and graphic designer who has exhibited his letter-based works in the United States and Great Britain. An ordained minister, he has served parishes in the Church of England and the Episcopal Church USA. He is editor of Alphabet, a journal of the lettering arts published by the Friends of Calligraphy, and author of One Hundred Miracles.

Illuminating Justice explores the call to social ethics in The Saint John's Bible, the first major handwritten and hand-illuminated Christian Bible since the invention of the printing press. Situating his close analysis of The Saint John's Bible's, illuminations in the context of contemporary biblical exegesis and Catholic teaching, Homrighausen shows how this project stimulates the ethical imagination of its readers and viewers on matters of justice for women, care for creation, and dialogue between Jews and Christians. Written for scholars, pastors, teachers, and any fan of The Saint John's Bible, this book shows how beauty and justice intertwine in this wondrous illuminated Bible for the new millennium.

Jonathan Homrighausen (MA, Graduate Theological Union) is currently pursuing a PhD in Hebrew Bible/Old Testament at Duke University. He spent two years with the Heritage Edition of *The Saint John's Bible* while working in Archives & Special Collections at Santa Clara University.




### Pentateuch

### **Psalms**

Visual representations o f chants from Benedictine, Native American, Muslim, Taoist, and other traditions are the basis for illuminations of the Psalms. The varying pitch of the chants is rendered graphically to

provide a motif for the abstract illumination. Every Psalm page features a small, gold graphic rendering of the chanting of the monks from Saint John's Abbey.

Jackson chose colors to represent different themes and designs to symbolize the different types of Psalms. He devised a way of weaving the two together that resulted in unique script, colors, and shading. 978-0-8146-9056-7 88 pp., \$99.95



## **Prophets**






## Gospels and Acts

## Letters and Revelation








### Word and Image The Hermeneutics of The Saint John's Bible


